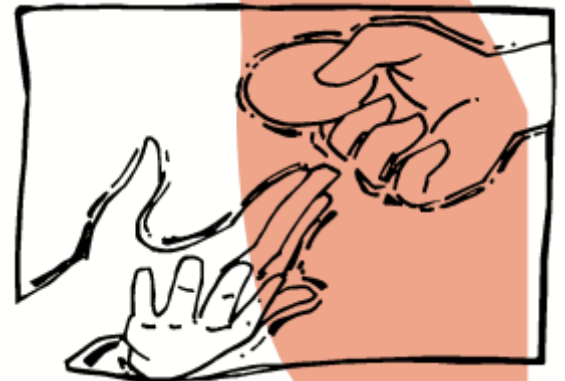

Zionsville Concert Band Outdoor Festival

onsville Concert Band has been invited to the festival, which offers a full day of music from 11:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. The band will perform a varied program of favorite Broadway show stoppers and popular classic marches.

The schedule for the day begins with Alexandria Community Band at 11:00 a.m.; the 38th Infantry Division National Guard Band at noon; Zionsville Concert Band at 1:00 p.m.; and the Tipton Community Band at 2:00 p.m. Following a break for dinner and rehearsal, the

four bands will join forces for a combined concert at 6:00 p.m., with such familiar pieces as “Stars and Stripes Forever,” “Battle Hymn of the Republic,” and “America the Beautiful.”

The festival is free and open to the public, and no tickets are required for admission.

Zionsville Concert Band consists of some 50 volunteer musicians from all walks of life who range in age from 18 to 83 but are united by a lifelong love of music. The band plays an ever-changing repertoire for all occasions, performing about a dozen concerts a year at retirement centers, churches, parks, and festivals in the Zionsville area and beyond.
